## Tips for detecting fake news

- The news triggers an emotional reaction. It makes you angry or curious whethe it turns out to be true or false.
- The information is designed for easy sharing (a meme)
- The news is not quoting official and expert sources. One should always check the source.
- Assess the design of the news/article/website. They ofter look amateurish, use stolen images and have grammar errors
- One should develop a critical minset; ask yourself: why has the news been writen? to promote a certain opinion/viewpoint? to convince me to click on another website?

## Tips for detecting fake news

- See if the news includes enough data and evidence.
- **02** Do not trust any image you see.
- Chech the "about us" and "contact us" section of the website.

  It should provide enough background on the website and real contacts.
- Pay atention to spelling, grammar and punctuation.

  Often news with a poor grammar are unreliable.
- Fake news often use excessive punctuation, all caps to trigger your attention
